Founded by Lloyd Morgan in 1956 as Morgan Power Apparatus, Morpac has been an electric utility supplier for more than 50 years. We have produced over 200 transmission line pullers and tensioners. Our cable handling expertise is most recently highlighted by a 6,400 foot, 38,000 lb-tension span in our own backyard over the Narrows in Tacoma, Washington. Field experience gained from over 25,000 miles of transmission line construction on five continents and unique jobs ranging from aerial trams to mooring winches have made Morpac Industries the leader in reliable cable handling equipment.

In 1962 Morgan Power Apparatus of Canada was formed, introducing a series of heavy-duty off-road crawlers. The capability of these machines to carry up to 60 tons over rough terrain at 20 mph make them ideal for use on remote projects to transport equipment and supplies. As a result of their outstanding durability, speed, and capacity, we adapted over 2,000 crawlers into rock drills, portable spars, and supply carriers for the logging and mining industries.

In 1974 Morpac complimented the electric utility market with the acquisition of a high voltage disconnect switch company. More than 30,000 substation and distribution switches ranging from 7.5kV to 765kV have been installed throughout the world, as well as 1,300 stored energy operators for automation of distribution switches.

Our unique nutating electric motor has been packaged as an electric valve actuator for numerous navy vessels, commercial ships, nuclear plants, and water treatment facilities. We have manufactured over 15,000 nutating motor valve actuators with an impressive reliability and quality record.

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Warranty

We warrant all equipment manufactured by us to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service. Our obligation under this warranty is limited to making good at our factory any part or parts thereof which shall, within (365) days after delivery of such equipment to the original purchaser, be returned to us with transportation charges prepaid, and shall disclose to our satisfaction to have been thus defective.

The manufacturer's warranty or obligation in connection with the sale of this equipment shall be expressly limited to the repair or replacement of defective parts, as stated above, all other damage and claims, statutory or otherwise, being hereby expressly waived by the purchaser and does not cover any labor costs incurred outside the manufacturer's factory.

This warranty does not apply to any equipment which shall have been repaired or altered outside of our factory by anyone other than our authorized representative, so as, in our judgment, to affect its efficient operation. Nor does it apply to any equipment which shall have been operated in any other manner than that recommended by us. We make no warranty whatever to cover accessories manufactured outside of our factory inasmuch as they are warranted by their respective manufacturers.

We reserve the right to incorporate at any time such changes in design or construction as we may deem necessary or desirable, without obligating ourselves to supply such new parts or equipment for said equipment previously manufactured.

The return of defective parts to our factory does not automatically authorize the shipment of new parts to replace them. All parts required by the purchaser to replace parts, which have failed in service, must be ordered by them on their regular purchase order and in the same manner as they would order parts for maintenance stock. In the event that our examination of the parts returned for credit discloses any defect in workmanship, material, or design, we will immediately issue a credit which will cancel the charge for similar parts previously shipped to the purchaser. We cannot allow credit on any parts which have not been returned to us for examination.

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
